

Design 7133

This pattern contains instructions and pattern pieces for making a Patchwork Quilt from scraps of material. Each material is numbered to aid in joining the pieces to form the block. The pattern pieces have been tested and they form a perfect block as shown on Block Chart.

The Illustration shows the finished quilt in two sizes:

Single Size Quilt -- 72" X 106"
Double Size Quilt -- 80" X 106"

MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS show the quantity of materials necessary for each size quilt, using 36" material. The entire quilt can be made of different scraps of material or use 4 different materials for each block and repeat throughout. Yardages are given for the latter arrangement.

PATTERN PIECES: Paste or trace pieces on thin cardboard. Cut out on the outer line. The inner line is the sewing line. Lay these pieces on correct material and mark around with a pencil. Cut out on the marked line. Mark and cut all pieces in this manner.

SUGGESTED MATERIALS:

- 1 - Light Print
- 2 - Dark Print
- 3 - Light Solid
- 4 - Dark Solid
- 5 - Solid

CUTTING THE BLOCKS: For each block, cut 24 patches. Cut three A patches of Material 1; cut three A patches of Material 2; cut six B patches of Material 3; cut twelve C patches of Material 4.

FORMING THE BLOCKS: Follow Block Chart carefully. Join 2 C patches to 1 B patch. Make 5 more such groups. Join 2 A patches. Make 3 more such groups. Join groups together to complete block.

JOINING THE BLOCKS: Join blocks in rows the length of quilt, following Illustration for the number of blocks needed. Join rows to form the size quilt desired. Every other row begins and ends with half a block. Cut whole blocks in half as needed.

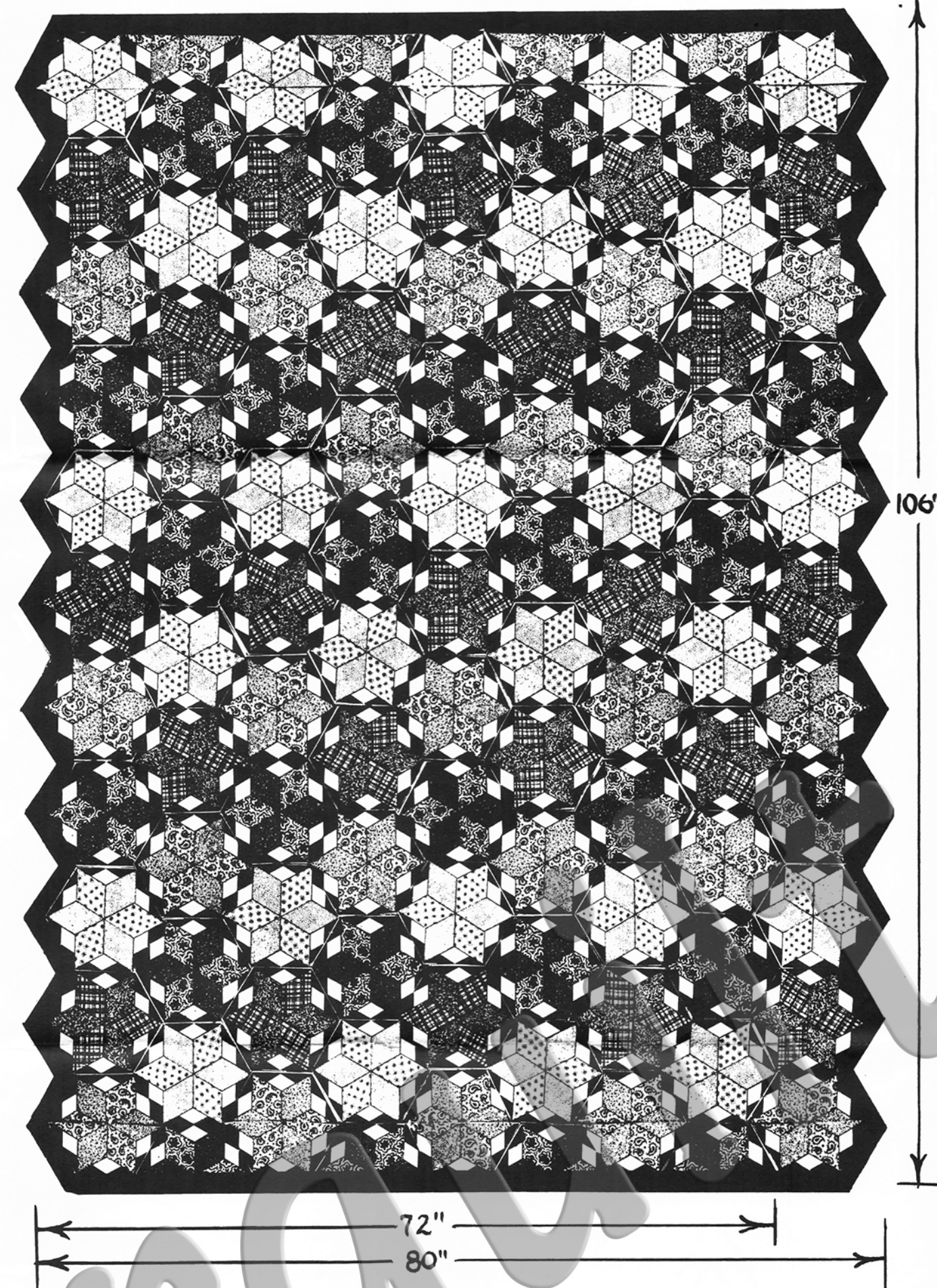
INTERLINING: Use sheet cotton or padding large enough to cover entire quilt. Tack it over entire joined blocks. Interline the border separately.

BORDER: Width of finished border is 2". Cut two 4-1/2" strips 1" longer than width finished quilt is to be. See dimensions for both size quilts on Illustration. Fold strips in half lengthwise. Interline these bands to same thickness as quilt. Match border to joined blocks; sew on so that all the raw edges are to back of quilt. For the side border (D patch) all the pieces have to be cut on a fold, thus eliminating an extra seam. Cut 22 and 22 reverse D patches. Sew these patches together in a zig-zag strip. Interline to same thickness as quilt. Match points of border to points of blocks; sew on so that all the raw edges are to back of quilt.

LINING: Single Size Quilt -- 3 Pieces --
23" X 105"
Double Size Quilt -- 3 Pieces --
26" X 105"

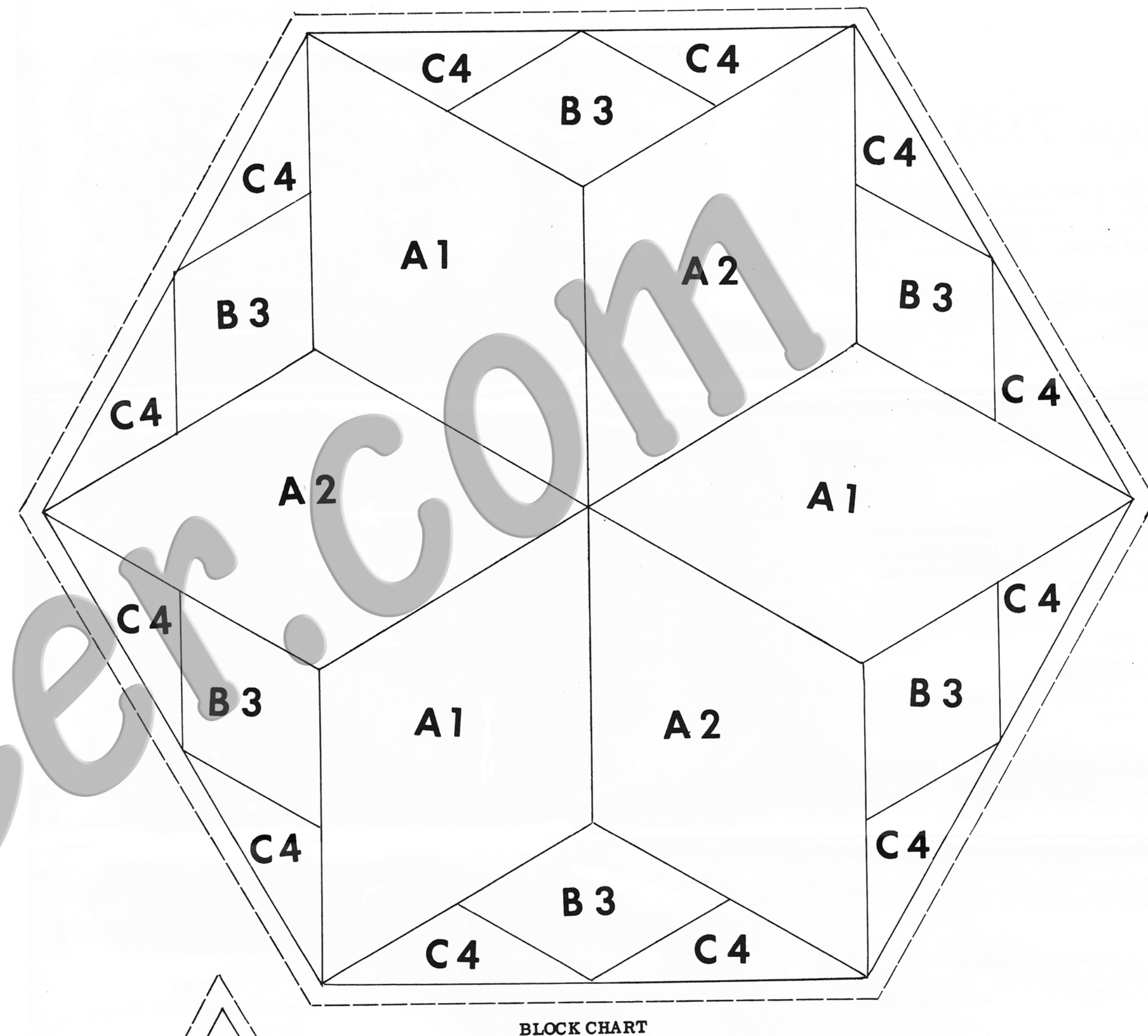
Seam together lengthwise down sides. Spread on floor or table, wrong side up. Tack securely at corners of blocks and edges of patches. Turn under edges which just extend over edges of blocks. Slip-stitch edges to blocks, covering border seams.
