

Design 7405

This pattern contains instructions and pattern pieces for making a patchwork quilt from scraps of material. Each material is numbered, and the patches lettered, to aid in joining the pieces to form the block. The pattern pieces have been tested and they form a perfect block as shown on Block Chart.

The illustration shows the finished quilt in two sizes: --
Single - 74" X 102"
and
Double - 88" X 116"

MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS give quantity of materials necessary for each size quilt, using 36" material. The entire quilt can be made of different scraps of material or use 10 different materials for each block and repeat throughout. Yardages are given for the latter arrangement. Use sheet cotton for interlining.

PATTERN PIECES: Paste or trace pieces on thin cardboard. Cut out on the outer line. Short lines at right angles to outer line indicate slashes. Lay these pieces on correct material and mark around with a pencil. Cut out on the marked line. The inner line indicates the sewing line. Mark and cut all pieces in the same manner.

SUGGESTED MATERIALS:

1 - Dark Print	6 - Dark Print
2 - Dark Print	7 - Light Print
3 - Dark Solid	8 - Light Print
4 - White	9 - Dark Print
5 - Light Print	10 - Light Print

CUTTING BLOCKS: For Each Butterfly Block: --

- cut 1 A and 1 A reverse patches;
- cut 1 B and 1 B reverse;
- cut 1 C and 1 C reverse;
- cut 6 D;
- cut 2 E;
- cut 1 F and 1 F reverse;
- cut 1 G and 1 G reverse;
- cut 1 H and 1 H reverse;
- cut 1 I and 1 I reverse;
- cut 1 J and 1 J reverse.

Single Quilt: From fabric 4, cut 20 triangles 10-1/2" X 10-1/2" X 14-1/2"; cut 4 triangles 7-1/2" X 7-1/2" X 10-1/2".

Double Quilt: From fabric 4, cut 24 triangles 10-1/2" X 10-1/2" X 14-1/2"; cut 4 triangles 7-1/2" X 7-1/2" X 10-1/2".

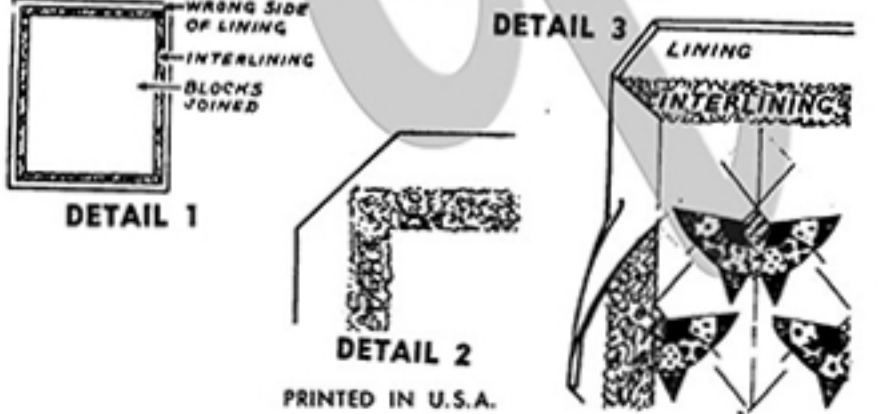
FORMING BLOCKS: Follow the Block Chart carefully. Join 3 D patches. Join E patch to D patches. Join C patch to D patches. Join F patch to D and E patches. Join on I patch. Join J patch to I patch. Cover this seam with outline stitch to make feelers for butterfly. Join H patch to C patch. Join on G patch. Join on B patch. Join A patch to B and F patches. Make another such group, using reverse patches. Join the 2 groups to form block.

JOINING BLOCKS: Follow illustration carefully. Join blocks in diagonal rows, starting at the upper left hand corner.

LINING AND BORDER:

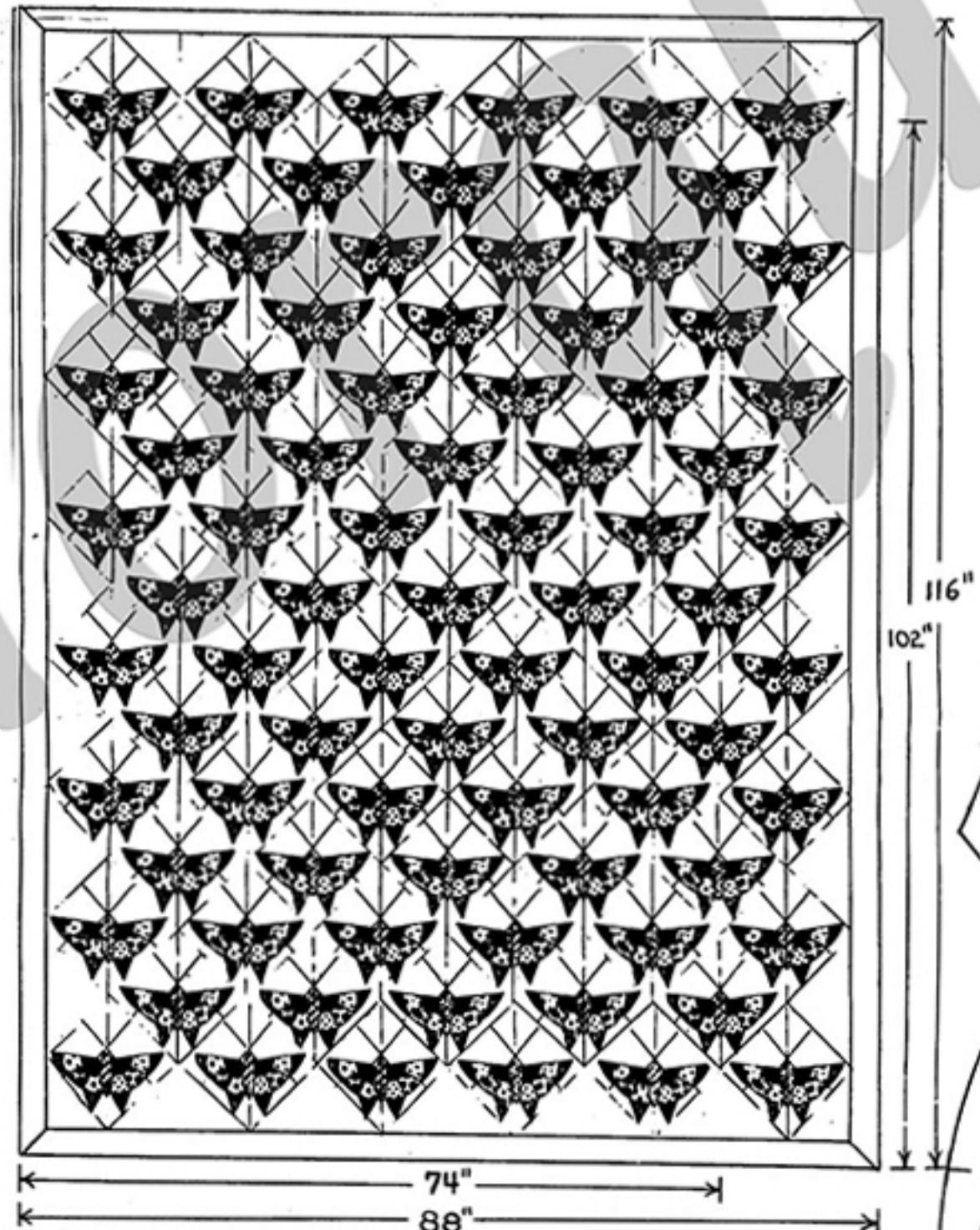
Single Size	-- 3 Pieces --
	27" X 108"
	and
Double Size	-- 3 Pieces --
	31" X 121-1/2"

Seam together lengthwise down sides. Spread on floor or table, wrong side up. Over this, place the sheet cotton interlining so that an equal amount extends on all edges (see Detail 1). Place joined blocks over interlining. Mitre corners by cutting across (see Detail 2). Tack all 3 thicknesses securely at the corners of blocks and edges of patches. Fold extending lining up over extending interlining. Turn under edges which just extend over edges of blocks (see Detail 3). Slip-stitch edges to blocks.

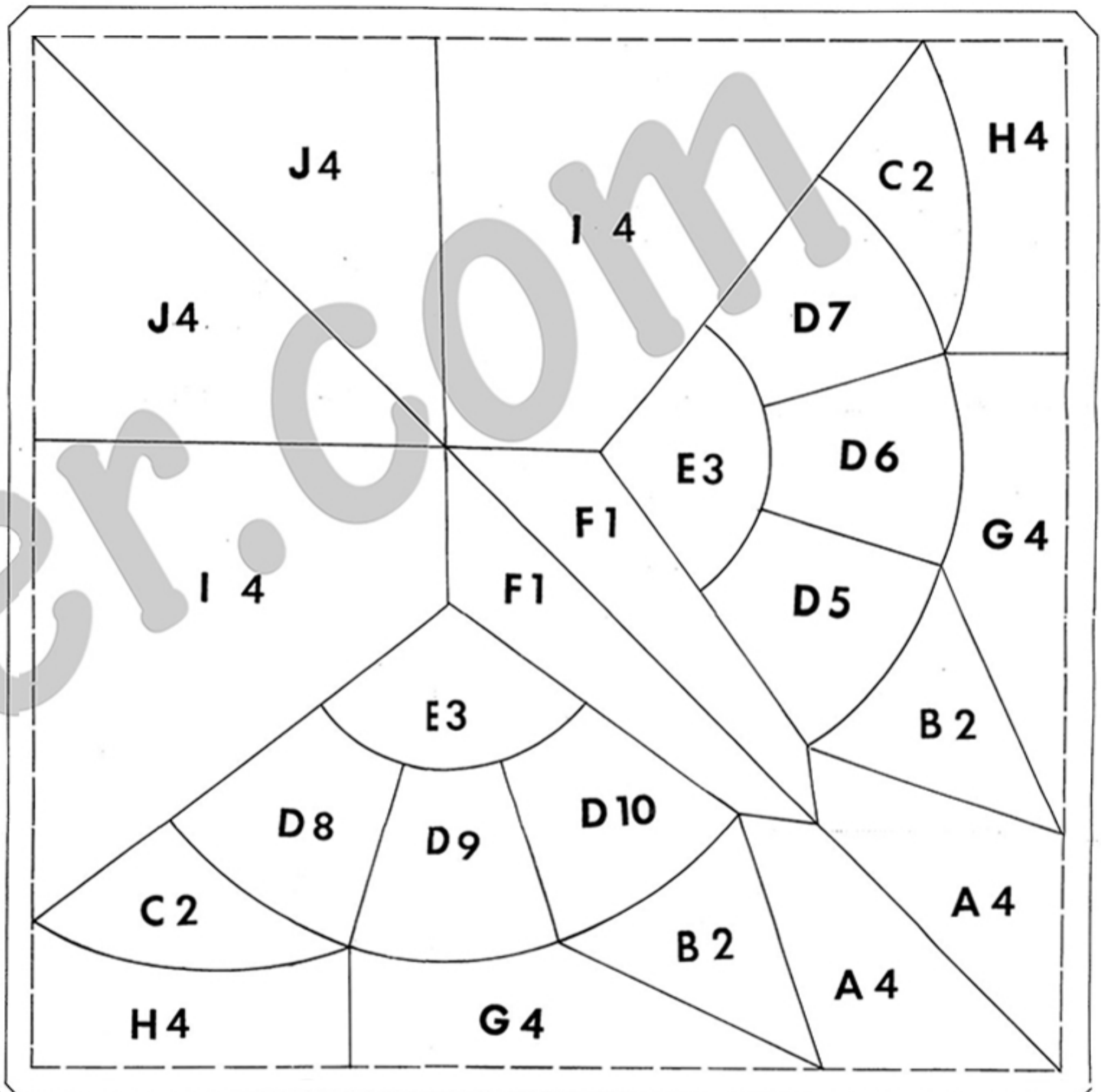
